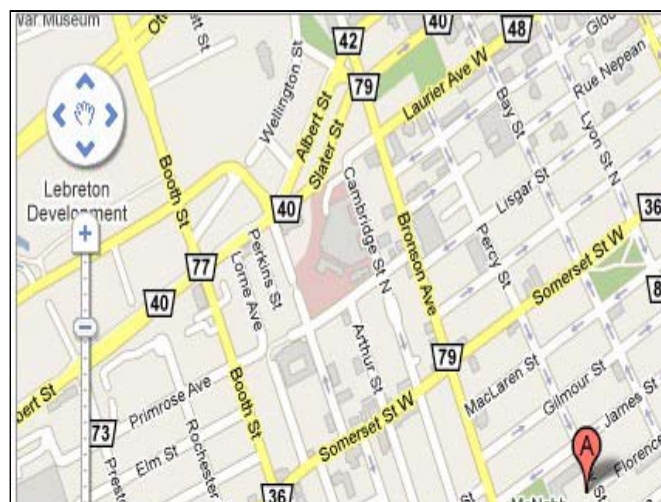

Lori articulated and practiced with another union-side labour and employment law firm in Ottawa until November 2005 when she joined Jewitt McLuckie & Associates. She obtained her L.L.B. from the University of Ottawa in 2003; her undergraduate degree is from the University of Victoria, British Columbia. Lori spent 6 years working and doing graduate studies in Brazil and is thus fluent in Portuguese as well as English.

Lori's practice involves labour law as well as many areas of civil litigation, particularly LTDI cases, employment law, personal injury (sexual abuse), defamation/libel and human rights law. Lori has also done some constitutional litigation in respect of sections 15 & 7 of the Charter of Rights and Freedoms.

In addition to her legal practice, Lori is an active member of the feminist and disability rights communities. She is a past National Board member of the Women's Legal Education and Action Foundation (LEAF), organized a conference on Equality Rights and the Internet for LEAF Ottawa, and has presented at and organized seminars/conferences for REACH Canada and its affiliates on long term disability litigation and environmental sensitivities.
